## SYNOPSIS

Qualify Web provides a mechanism whereby the Login Screen can be customized. This can be used to 'brand' the Login Screen and provide other information.

This is achieved by editing an HTML template file that is part of the Qualify Web installation.

### LOGIN.TMPL.HTML

The login.tmpl.html file is a file that can contain HTML that is injected into the Qualify Web Login page.

#### Finding the login.tmpl.html file

You will need access to the installation folder for Qualify Web on your web server. This can be achieved using File Explorer, if the Web Server is located on your local network, or using an FTP client application, such as FileZilla.

The login.tmpl.html file is located in the \templates\Account folder.

#### Adding Custom Content to the login.tmpl.html file

Open the file in an editor. This can be Notepad but an HTML-friendly editor, such as Notepad++ or one of the Visual Studio editions, will make editing easier.

Any content you add will need to be contained within a new <DIV> element that is sized as 100% wide and 100vh high. You can color the background of the DIV or use a background image.

Qualify Web uses the Bootstrap grid system which enables you to break up a DIV into rows and columns. It is best to use this system to correctly arrange content within the page.

Please note that the Qualify Web login form is contained within a DIV that will always be positioned in the centre of the page, so you should avoid adding content that will be obscured by this form.

#### Background Image Example

The following HTML is an example of how to add a background image to the Login Screen.

<div style="width: 100%; height: 100vh; background-image: url(url of the image you wish to display);
background-size: 100% auto">

width: 100% - Sets the DIV width to 100% of the containing item

height: 100vh - Sets the DIV height to 100% of the viewport height

background-size: 100% auto — Makes sure the image is sized correctly and maintains the correct aspect ratio
